



# Victorian Curriculum Policy

## **Rationale:**

Implementation of the Victorian Curriculum across the school will provide all students with a sequential curriculum framework that guides their learning, as well as providing measures of learning achievement that allow students, teachers and parents the opportunity to assess student performance against standardised learning outcomes.

## **Purpose:**

To improve student learning through the implementation of the Victorian Curriculum across all domains and across all year levels in a manner consistent with departmental requirements and locally identified needs.

## **Implementation:**

- The school is committed to the implementation of the Victorian Curriculum across all year levels.
- Staff will be allocated the responsibility to lead a team in the development and implementation of a strategic plan for the integration of the Victorian Curriculum across the school.
- In doing so, all Department of Education and Training (DET) timelines and reporting requirements must be met.
- Whole school professional development opportunities will be provided, as well as personal professional development plans developed that cater for the Victorian Curriculum needs of each staff member.
- All staff members are required to work with their respective teams in the development and implement a curriculum that reflects the Victorian Curriculum and responds to a student's identified needs.
- Student achievement will be measured and reported to students, parents, DET and the wider community against Victorian Curriculum achievement levels.
- All staff will participate in the collection of student achievement data, and will have input into school direction decisions resulting from interpretations of student achievement data.
- Implementation of the Victorian Curriculum will be a key performance indicator of each staff member's Professional Development Plan.
- School council will provide adequate resources for the implementation of the Victorian Curriculum and associated professional development.

## **Evaluation:**

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's three year review cycle.
